**West Sussex Rail Users Annual General Meeting
Saturday 14th May 2011**

I would like to make readers aware the West Sussex Rail Users Association (WSRUA) annual general meeting will be held in Horsham on Saturday 14th May starting at 10:15am. The meeting will take place at the Salvation Army Community Centre in Booth Way, Horsham, RH13 5PZ which is also accessible by foot from Depot Road. The guest speaker will be David Scorey, Franchise Improvement Director for Southern Railway and members and non-members are welcome to attend.

WSRUA seeks to represent the views and needs of all rail users of the Arun Valley and West Coastway to train operators and Network Rail. Current issues which we will be raising at the meeting include: overcrowding on peak time trains to and from London; station facilities at Horsham, in particular likely problems arising from the planned "Improvements" there; the continued failure to provide adequate car parking along the Arun Valley, particularly at Horsham, Pulborough and Barnham; the need for longer platforms at Littlehaven; the general lack of enthusiasm of Southern Railway and Network Rail to promote and develop the Arun Valley line and to improve the frequency and reliability of services.
